To be eligible for federal student aid at Vanguard University a student must be a U.S. Citizen (U.S. National), <u>U.S. Permanent Resident, or other Eligible Noncitizen</u>. To establish eligibility for financial aid, students must provide one or more documents appropriate to their citizenship status as shown below. Students may use <u>G-639</u> to request photocopies of their original INS documentation. Do not submit this document unless requested by the Financial Aid Office.

U.S. Citizen	 Certificate of Live Birth; must indicate United States U.S. Passport; may be current or expired but not limited U.S. Passport card Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561); must have student's name, the date the certificate was issued, application number and certificate number Certificate of Birth Abroad (FS-545 or DS-1350) or Consular Report of Birth Abroad (FS-240); must have embossed seal reading "United States of America" and "State Department" Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570); Must have student's name and petition number, certificate number, Alien Registration Number, name of the court and date where naturalization occurred
□ Noncitizen National	o U.S. Passport; may be current or expired but not limited. Must be stamped "Noncitizen National."
□ U.S. Permanent Resident	 Permanent Resident Card (I-551 or I-551C); must have currently valid expiration date. Submit copy of the front and back. Alien Registration Receipt Card (I-151 or I-151C); must have currently valid expiration date. Submit copy of the front and back. Foreign Passport; must be stamped "Processed for I-551" with expiration date I-94 or Customs Border Patrol (BP) I-94A; must be stamped "Processed for I-551 or Temporary Form I-551," with appropriate information filled in Machine Readable Immigrant Visa (MRIV); the MRIV will appear in the holder's foreign passport. If the passport is unexpired and endorsed with an admission stamp and the statement "Upon endorsement serves as temporary I-551 evidencing permanent residence for 1 year," it serves as a temporary I-551 and as valid documentation for establishing aid eligibility.
