2009-10 Season Outlook

The Vanguard Lions return to the hardwood for the 2009-10 season after a disappointing 2008-09 campaign. Posting an overall record of 7-22, the Lions will be looking to turn the program back around to the right direction with yet another difficult schedule in front of them. VU placed ninth in the GSAC with a conference mark of 6-14, and the Lions will be aiming to get back into the upper half of the conference standings as in 2007-08. VUSC lost senior point guard Andrew Ellis who was second on the team in scoring and assists, as well as part-time starters senior Brandon Glenn and Tony Trajeski. However, the returning roster looks to be one of the most veteran in recent years, led by senior point guard Greg Scott. Scott, a 2008 All-GSAC and NAIA Honorable Mention selection, has three years of starting experience and will be key to the Lions' success this year. Fellow 4-year senior Dennis Heenan is ready for a career year as an all-around player for the Lions. Elvis Whitelow and Mitch Boyce, both in their 2nd year at VU, complete the senior class and are expected to be huge contributors for VU. Alex Chapman, a second-semester addition last year, will be counted on again, as well as another handful of returning sophomores and juniors who should be ready to cash in on the experience of previous years. Coach Fred Litzenberger, now in his fourth year as the head coach of the Lions, has added a pair of transfers (Billy Azizi and Allen Major) and a couple of freshmen (Daniel Cornelius and Tremayne) to the roster and feels the new additions will also make an immediate impact. Vanguard has a difficult preseason schedule, facing NCAA Division I UC Irvine, as well as Division II schools Cal Poly Pomona, CSU Dominguez Hills, and Cal State San Bernardino. The GSAC teams will be as strong as ever and Litzenberger's hope is to put together a team that can compete in the upper echelon or arguably the best conference in the NAIA. If experience and depth have anything to do with it, the Lions will be loaded and ready to get the job done.
