Transfer Rules for Traditional Undergraduate Students

- All courses must be taken for a letter grade, and a grade of "C-" or higher must be earned. However, grades from transfer work do not count toward your gpa at VU.
- 24 of the last 30 units of a student's degree must be taken at VU.
- A maximum of 70 units may be transferred from a Community College.
- Community College courses are considered lower division (100 or 200 level), so they do not count toward the 40 Upper Division Units needed to graduate.
- Lab science courses must be on-site labs. No online, tv, or distance learning labs will transfer.
- For specific major requirements, please see the Vanguard University catalog. Transfer students are encouraged to complete major requirements at Vanguard and general education requirements at the community college.
