Deposit, along with the enclosed Acknowledgment of Acceptance form within two weeks
from the date of your acceptance letter. The Enrollment Deposit is applied toward the first
semester's tuition and is non-refundable. (You may pay your enrollment deposit at
www.vanguard.edu/GradDeposit).
File the 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), online at
fafsa.gov , if you would like to receive a Federal Stafford Loan. Vanguard University's
FAFSA school code is 001293. You must complete the Student Account Clearance process
with the Office of Accounting Operations by January 3, 2023 , so file your FAFSA
early.
Submit your final, degree-posted bachelor's degree transcript and
evidence of your prerequisite courses no later than January 3, 2023.
Mandatory New Student Orientation will be held the week prior to the start of
classes. Additional information will be sent from the Clinical Psychology program office.
Classes begin the week of Monday, January 9, 2023.
