Secure your seat at Vanguard University by submitting your \$100 Enrollment Deposit, along with the enclosed <i>Acknowledgment of Acceptance</i> form, within two weeks from the date of your acceptance letter. The Enrollment Deposit is applied toward the first semester's tuition and is non-refundable. (You may pay your enrollment deposit online at
vanguard.edu/GradDeposit). File the 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), online at fafsa.gov, if you would like to be considered for Federal Student Aid, including Stafford Loans. Vanguard University's FAFSA school code is 001293. You must complete the Student Account Clearance process with the Office of Accounting Operations by January 3, 2023, so file your FAFSA early.
Submit your final, degree-posted bachelor's degree transcript and any other outstanding items no later than January 3, 2023.
Attend classes starting the week of January 9, 2023.
