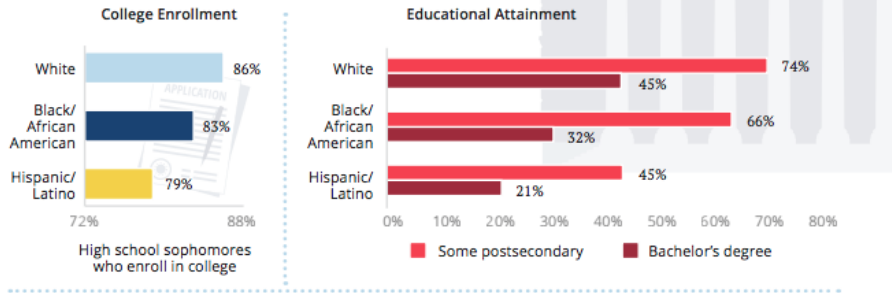
## TITLE V - AGENDA
