## January 30, 2018 TITLE V - AGENDA

The goal of Title V is to strengthen and enhance the pipeline of Hispanic and low-income students from early engagement to engaged alumni.

**2015** :: This goal will be accomplished through the comprehensive expansion and consolidation of student support services forming Vanguard's Integrated Pathways for Success (**VIPs**) and creating an Institute for Faculty Development (**IFD**) to train faculty in evolving pedagogical advances with culturally diverse populations.

2017 :: The overarching goal is to develop comprehensive integrated pathways for Hispanic students to enter the teaching profession in the STEM disciplines through one collaborative and two synergistic activities. Vanguard's Integrated STEM Teach Achievement (Vista) program will train exceptional educators in Chemistry and Biology; the Intensive Pedagogical and Research Experiences Program (iPrep), will launch a postdoctoral training program for recent PhD recipients aspiring to STEM education. Vanguard will also partner with local HSI 2-year institutions, including Orange Coast College, to create a four-year integrated program of professional preparation Vanguard's STEM Transfer with Excellence Program (V-Steps) that will open access to teacher preparation for community college students and support them through that transition.
