Devereaux about a possible Domestic Violence incident that he had witnessed and reported to Costa Mesa Police. CSO Devereaux said that he was working his assigned Fair Parking assignment at the Scott Parking lot entrance to Vanguard University from the Civic Center, when he saw and heard a male subject yelling and running towards a female adult who was walking e/b on the north side of Fair Drive at Civic Center. He saw that the male subject grabbed the female around her chest while yelling at her, and it appeared that he prevented her from continuing eastbound on the sidewalk, while possibly forcing her to walk back westbound. He said the male appeared angry and the female was upset and didn't appear to want to go with him. CSO Devereaux said that he saw and recognized Costa Mesa Police Department C. Cordero nearby in the Civic Center parking lot, where she was working with Explores on parking vehicles. Detective Cordero summoned a patrol vehicle via her patrol radio and a motor officer K. <b>Notes:</b>	<p>Summary: On 8-27-21, at approximately 1835 hours, while working as a Campus Public Safety Officer at Vanguard University, I received a call on the duty phone from Blake Johnson (Residence Life staff) reference an apparently homeless male, wearing an orange shirt and blue hair, in the food line of the private picnic for parents and students, held in the Student Center lawn. Officer C. Dunn and I responded from the Campus Safety Office, and we saw that there were hundreds of campus guests in the lawn area and food line. As I neared the food serving area, I saw a male adult walking away and carrying an empty paper plate. I saw that he turned westbound at the Balboa dorm and continued past the Newport Dorm where I angled him off and caught up to him. I contacted him on the northwest/front side of Newport dorm and I told him that I received a call about him, and asked him why he was there. He said he was just getting food. I asked him if he had family attending and he said that his little brother was a student and their parents were part of the event. He said that he left quickly because he didn't want to be contacted and embarrass them. I asked what his brother's name was, and he said it was "Daniel..uh.. Cressen". He said his brother's date of birth was 7-13-02. He identified himself, verbally as Justin Cressin (22 years). He also said his brother was a Junior, but later told Officer Dunn that his brother was a Sophomore. He offered twice to "just leave" so that it wouldn't be a problem for his brother, as I checked the Res Life Star Report on my cellphone. I was unable to find a Daniel Cressin on the report. We offered to call his parents to confirm that they were here and he was with them, and he said he was going to go to his car and get his cellphone. He then said he was going to just leave the campus. I admonished him that this was a private campus and event, and he left westbound towards Vanguard Way. We walked back to the event and saw the same subject walking e/b towards the serving line, quickly. We followed him and saw that he picked up a gray backpack from the area where I originally saw him, and he walked away e/b towards Newport Boulevard and left the campus. <b>Notes:</b>	<p><b>Summary:</b> On 9-16-21, Thursday, at approximately 2227 hours, while working as a Campus Public Safety Officer for Vanguard University, I received a radio call from Officer J. Archuleta notifying me that he had visual observation of a male adult matching the description of an earlier subject on campus who had been verbally warned, twice, and admonished for trespassing. He described the subject as possibly the same male who had verbally identified himself as "Justin Collier" and had possibly grabbed a female student on the sidewalk surrounding the campus, earlier today. I responded to the northeast side of the campus to assist Officer Archuleta, and I immediately contacted the Costa Mesa Police Department and notified them of the circumstances of this incident and the earlier incidents today.</p> <p>As I arrived on-scene, I saw that the subject was still sitting against a tree, on Vanguard University property at the northern edge of the campus and near the Fair Drive Sidewalk. As I pulled up, the subject stood up and walked approximately 50-75 yards, westbound, then stood for several minutes in front of an electrical utility box. We stopped our vehicles and observed and waited for police, as the subject stood there. After approximately ten minutes, the subject started walking again, westbound on the south sidewalk of Fair drive, and as he started to cross the campus entrance driveway in front of the Scott Building, he again came on-campus and walked westbound through the parking lot. I then drove to the front of the Scott building, stopped and attempted to speak with him. I asked him several times why he was on campus and about being admonished earlier for trespassing. He continued walking without talking to me and entered the Civic Center lot. We watched him walk about 75 yards into the Civic Center lot and stop, then stand there rocking back and forth. Costa Mesa Police Officer D. Reeves, who handled the earlier call, arrived at approximately 2050 hours, and I pointed the subject out to him. Officer Reeves asked me if I was willing to sign an Order of Arrest By Private Person, and I told him that I was. He asked if the subject had come onto the property in this instance and I told him that he did. Officer Reeves said that Costa Mesa Police had also responded to another incident, last night, at a private residence, and the same subject was arrested for trespassing at that location, so they would have his fingerprints and true identity on file. The subject was arrested and transported by Costa Mesa Police, and Officer Reeves provided the true identity for the subject as: Pachoco, Justin Talamage (12-29-85), and a Costa Mesa Police Report number of 21-015259.
