***NOTE:**

- Scenic Painting, Set Construction, and Costume Construction may be taken any semester. You must take Scenic Painting a total of 3 times, Set and/or Costume Construction a total of 2 times.
- All theatre majors are expected to participate on a minimum of 1 crew each semester.
- Senior year take Core Curriculum courses listed appropriately to have 13 units the semester of your Senior Project.

1. **IMPORTANT:** Lighting Design, Period Styles, Producing/Theatre Management, Scenic Design, and Digital Design must be taken these semesters due to the rotation.
2. Script Analysis OR Playwriting is required. They are offered alternate springs. If you take both, one serves as an elective. If you do not take both you will need an additional 3 elective units.
3. You are strongly advised to take Prop Building/Design as an elective. It is only offered Spring 2017. If it is not taken, an additional 3 elective units will be needed.
4. You are strongly advised to take Career Directions & Your Daily Bread as an elective, as it is an excellent career planning resource. If it is not taken, an additional 3 elective units will be needed.
5. Theatre Internship should be served during the summer, pending approval.
