- Secure your seat at Vanguard University** by submitting your \$100 Enrollment Deposit, along with the enclosed *Acknowledgment of Acceptance* form within two weeks from the date of your acceptance letter. The Enrollment Deposit is applied toward the first semester's tuition and is non-refundable. (*You may pay your enrollment deposit online at [vanguard.edu/GradDeposit](http://vanguard.edu/GradDeposit)*).
- File the 2020-21 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), online at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov)**, if you would like to receive a Federal Stafford Loan. Vanguard University's FAFSA school code is 001293. You must be financially registered by **August 1, 2020**, so file your FAFSA early.
- Submit your final, degree-posted bachelor's degree transcript and evidence of your prerequisite courses no later than August 10, 2020.**
- Classes begin the week of Monday, August 24, 2020.** A mandatory New Student Orientation will be held the week prior, so please plan accordingly. Additional information will be sent from the Clinical Psychology Program Office.
