The TEACH Grant award offers a maximum yearly amount of \$4,000 in grants to students who agree to serve as a full-time teacher in a high-need field in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families. For 2018-2019, the maximum award is 6.6% less than \$4,000 due to federal sequestration.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: I understand that the TEACH Grant Program has specific service obligations that must be met in order for the award to remain a grant. If I fail to meet all the conditions of the award or if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest accrued from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.
