I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, OR the Federated States of Micronesia.
I entered the U.S. for the first time after my 26th birthday.
I entered the U.S. as a lawful nonimmigrant on a valid visa AND remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after my 26th birthday.
I did not register for the Selective Service System between ages 18-25. Additional documentation required. See below.
I spent the entire time hospitalized/incarcerated/institutionalized. (Please submit proof of status for this entire period.)
I spent the entire time enrolled in an officer procurement program at a qualifying institution. (Please submit proof of status for this entire period.)
I spent the entire time as a commissioned or reserved Public Health Officer. (Please submit proof of status for this entire period.)
I don't meet any of the other criteria. Submit a Status Information Letter from Selective Service System AND submit a signed and dated detailed statement that explains why you failed to register in accordance with federal law. The statement and supporting documentation must provide a preponderance of evidence to show that your failure to register was not done knowingly or willfully. Be sure to include the following information:

Did you know you were supposed to register between ages 18-25? Why didn't you register? What living arrangements and/or personal circumstances prevented you from registering?

Section B: Certification You must sign this form certifying that the information you provided is true. Misrepresentation of facts related to Selective Service will be reported to the Department of Education, and your financial aid will be cancelled.
