Room and Board	What is the room and board rate? What does it include?	
Flights	Make sure to remember taxes/fees and baggage charges	
Visa	Does the program require a student or travel visa?	
Entrance Tax	Does the country require an entrance tax upon arrival?	
Passport	Is your passport current and will not expire within 6 months of the end date of your program?	
Insurance	Is international insurance included in the program fees or needed?	
Study Abroad Administrative Fee	Is there a fee for this program?	\$500
Food	Duration of program, additional travel	
Lodging	If not included in program cost, what lodging options are available?	
Transportation	Local transportation needs (bus, taxi, train)	
Tourism/Expeditions	Local travel on weekends (additional countries/cities, museums, concerts, sightseeing)	
Clothing	Is different clothing needed for this program (winter, business, etc.)	
Misc. Expenses	Course books, international phone or plan, bedding, computer, camera, adapter/converter, etc.)	
Total Expenses	Sum of all expenses	
Federal/State Aid	Is any Federal or State aid available for this program?	
Scholarships	Awarded scholarships	
Total Income/Aid	Sum of expected aid to be applied towards program
