

<b>INSTRUCTION METHODS</b>		
<b>CODE</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>DEFINITION</b>
<b>CC</b>	Conference Course	By special arrangement, 1-3 students received individualized instruction. Structure of the course is variable including, but not limited to, laboratory, lecture, online, remote, and/or seminar.
<b>CLC</b>	Clinical	Conducted at hospital or other facility; students provide direct patient care under the supervision of clinical faculty. Offered concurrently with an associated course to foster application of theory to practice.
<b>FE</b>	Field Experience	Experiential/applied learning in a variety of settings, mostly away from campus.
<b>FLEXC</b>	Flex-VU Campus	Designed to meet on campus at specified times but has built-in options for alternative attendance for those who do not attend the scheduled class session.
<b>FLEXV</b>	Flex-VU Virtual	An online course where a student has an opportunity to attend the course at a specific day and time via web conferencing but options for alternative attendance for those who do not attend the scheduled class session.
<b>HYB</b>	Hybrid	Meets mostly on campus but with an online component .
<b>IN</b>	Internship	A supervised learning experience off campus with a minimum number of hours, scheduled by the internship site, required.
<b>IS</b>	Individual Study	Initiated by the student, who must secure an appropriate sponsoring faculty member to supervise and evaluate a special course of study or project.
<b>LAB</b>	Laboratory	Provides hands-on experience with special-purpose equipment.
<b>LEC</b>	Lecture	Meets on campus.
<b>ONLA</b>	Online Asynchronous	Online course that does not require attendance at scheduled times.
<b>ONLS</b>	Online Synchronous	Online course that requires attendance at scheduled times via web conference.
<b>PE</b>	Physical Education Activity	Involves physical movement. Can be on- or off-campus.
<b>PAI</b>	Private Acting Instruction	Scheduled individually with one instructor.
<b>PMI</b>	Private Instruction	Scheduled individually with one instructor, emphasis is on practice, feedback, and coaching.
<b>PVI</b>	Private Voice Instruction	Scheduled individually with one instructor.
<b>SEM</b>	Seminar	Discussion, applications, presentations by students, and written research papers.
<b>RES</b>	Research	Independent research by the student under supervision of a faculty member or group of faculty. Student conducts research that is expected to lead to a specific project such as thesis, report or publication.
