Author's name and publication date NOT used in text:

Two Authors: It was shown in the late 1980's that "..." (Quete & Tipton 1989:121).

Using Author's Name, Date, and Page #:

One Author: Quete believes that "..." (1998:77).

Multiple Authors: It was demonstrated that ". . ." (Quete, Marquis and Brock 1997:87).

[note: for more than three authors (Quete et al. 1991:243)]
